As part of this initiative, Georgian College and the YMCA of Simcoe/Muskoka will be hosting two informational sessions and invite community organizations to learn more about how to participate.

"At these sessions, we'll focus on how to make the landscape strongly sustainable through an innovation ecosystem that applies the social factors of health as its measures of flourishing."

The two upcoming sessions – May 22 and May 28 – aim to engage and involve community organizations in the Future of Belonging initiative.

The sessions follow a recent announcement by the YMCA of Simcoe/Muskoka and Georgian at the college's Research, Innovation, Scholarship and Entrepreneurship (RISE) Symposium. The YMCA of Simcoe/Muskoka and Georgian's Social Innovation unit are taking steps forward with the launch of a Community Innovation Network, a first-of-its-kind initiative in the region that will explore how various community services can maintain relevancy into the future, as well as how they can collaborate to cause change and bring agency to underrepresented groups.
